Who can use school facilities?

Our school facilities are available to the fullest extent possible for education, cultural or recreational activities, and community services. These groups include: school related groups, volunteer youth groups, volunteer adult groups, community centered groups, and other groups such as fundraising or profit-making organizations.

What facilities do schools have?

All elementary and secondary schools in Trillium Lakelands District School Board are available for rent. Most schools are available Monday to Friday from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. Most schools are also available on weekends but additional custodial overtime charges will apply. A list of all the available space and costs associated is available through our online booking registration form at tldsb.ca. Most schools will have a classroom, library, gymnasium, and field available for rent. Due to cleaning and maintenance requirements, our schools are not available for rent during the last two weeks of August before school start-up, the first week of school in September, during March Break, and the last week of school in June .

Is there a cost?

Most groups are subject to a permit fee, rental fee, as well as hourly rates based on set up or take down by the custodian. Computers, technical equipment, and teacher supplies are not available for rent.

How do I book a school facility?

The Community Use of Schools booking process is an opportunity to book one of our beautiful, geographically diverse sites available in the District of Muskoka, Haliburton County, and City of Kawartha Lakes. All bookings are now completed online through our online booking registration form found at tldsb.ca.

When must I submit my permit?

Permits must be received a minimum of 10 business days prior to the event. Insurance certificates need to be presented at this time or arrangements to purchase insurance through Trillium Lakelands District School Board must be made.

Do I need liability insurance?

All users are required to provide proof of a minimum of \$2 million general liability insurance with Trillium Lakelands District School Board listed as additional insured. If an applicant does not have their own liability insurance, coverage can be purchased through the school board. Further information can be provided upon request.

Will my bookings be cancelled?

It is possible for groups to have their bookings cancelled because school requirements take precedence over community use of schools. Every effort will be made to provide two weeks notification whenever possible. Failure to notify the Board of a cancellation by a community group, will result in full charges for the rental of the facility. All use of schools by community groups will be cancelled on inclement weather days.
