G7 Student Senate

Five students from the seven-member G7 Student Senate shared their motivation and experiences over the year representing the seven secondary schools in the board. Each of the students expressed how the leadership opportunities have impacted them personally, in their school, and in their community. During the 2014-2015 school year the G7 held a bonding day in the fall, celebrated a mental wellness week, raised thousands of boxes of pasta in the Great Pasta Challenge, toured each high school in February and March, planned and orchestrated a student leadership conference in April for over 80 students, and raised funds for the nourishment program at Gravenhurst Public School. Three of the seven members will be returning for a second term next year.

Administrative Reports:

2015-2016 Budget

Bob Kaye, Superintendent of Business, presented to trustees the 2015-2016 draft budget. The \$201,599,029 budget reflects a balanced budget with the exception of surplus management initiatives totaling \$3,991,000. Any deficit amount that exceeds one percent of the Board's operating grants for the school year (\$1.9 million) requires approval from the Ministry of Education. Trustees will be requesting approval from the Ministry for \$3,991,000 to be drawn from surplus.

The draft 2015-2016 budget will be presented to trustees for approval at the June 9, 2015 Regular Meeting of the Board.
