

# Getting started with digital books in your browser

Use these steps to borrow digital books from your school and start reading or listening to them right in your web browser.

## Step 1

Go your school's OverDrive website:

## Step 2

Sign in with your student ID or school login.

## Step 3

Borrow a book.

## Step 4

Go to your **Checkouts** page (under your **Account**). From there, click the **Read** or **Listen** button to open the book in your browser.

## About our browser-based reader and listener

OverDrive Read is a browser-based reader, and OverDrive Listen is a browser-based audiobook player. They don't require software or downloads; they just require an up-to-date web browser.

# Getting started with the OverDrive app

You can use the free OverDrive app (available in all major app stores) to borrow and download digital books from your school.

## Step 1

Install the OverDrive app from your device's app store or from [app.overdrive.com](http://app.overdrive.com).

## Step 2

In the app, select **Sign up** and create an OverDrive account. This is different than your student ID or school login. Or, if you're under 13 or don't want an OverDrive account\*, select the **Under 13 years old or using OverDrive through your school?** link.

\*An OverDrive account enables you to download and sync EPUB eBooks on multiple devices.

## Step 3

Find and save your school in the OverDrive app.

## Step 4

Tap on your school's name to open its OverDrive collection, sign in using your student ID or school login, and borrow a book.

## Step 5

Borrowed books appear on your **Checkouts** page (under your **Account**). From there, select **Download** or **Add to app** to download the book to your app bookshelf.

## About the OverDrive app

The latest version of the OverDrive app is available for Android, Chromebooks, iOS (iPhone, iPad, iPod touch), Kindle Fire tablets, Kobo tablets, NOOK tablets, and Windows 8 and up.
