



The Accommodation Review Committees (ARC) for each of the two areas provided a report to the board which was included as an appendix to the two individual final reports. The final staff report provided a summary of response and feedback from the public meetings, a summary of feedback from the community, and an outline of the ARC report.

**Summary and Recommendations for Honey Harbour Public School**

Kaye stated that multi-grade classrooms are not ideal for learners. Based on the information provided throughout the process, TLDSB staff recommend closing Honey Harbour Public School at the end of the 2016-2017 school year and that students are transferred to Glen Orchard Public School at the beginning of the 2017-2018 school year. Kaye also stated that TLDSB staff have worked with the Simcoe County District School Board and have confirmed with their staff that students could attend schools in either Coldwater or Victoria Harbour, with transportation provided to the students based on the applicable policies of the Simcoe County District School Board.

**Summary and Recommendation for Lady Eaton Elementary School**

The recommendations for Lady Eaton Elementary School remains unchanged. It is proposed that the school would close at the end of the 2017-2018 school year and students would transfer to Scott Young Public School at the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year. It was also recommended that facility services staff submit plans for a four classroom purpose-built Junior Kindergarten addition at Scott Young Public School to the Ministry of Education Priority Capital projects. Staff suggest that the board work with the CKL Consolidated Municipal Service Manager (CMSM) to apply to the Ministry of Education for funding to construct an addition to house a daycare facility at Scott Young Public School.

The two reports were presented to trustees for information. Community members now have the opportunity to delegate the board at special meetings to be held on April 4, 2017 for the Honey Harbour Public School review and on April 5, 2017 for the Lady Eaton Elementary School review. Following the special board meetings, a final report with recommendations will come from the Director of Education to the April 25<sup>th</sup> Regular Meeting of the Board.
