## 2018-2019 Annual Report

School council chairs were invited to attend four District Council / Parent Involvement Committee (DSC-PIC) meetings in the 2018-2019 school year:

- Thursday, November 8, 2018: Director Hope spoke about the provincial government's rescinding of the Healthy and Physical Education Curriculum and the board's considerations in the classroom. He provided an update regarding the direction of math instruction. He also provided information on the status of Honey Harbour Public School and Scott Young Public School accommodations. Sonya Vellenga, District Manager of Mental Health Services, spoke about the role of the 15 Student Services Attendance Counsellors who support students across the board.
- Thursday, January 17, 2019: Director Hope addressed anaphylaxis concerns during community use of schools after school hours events. He noted that there had been no information provided by the Ministry as yet regarding the public consultation process they had undertaken. Director Hope provided an update on the new Ministry of Education regulations regarding nutrition and food handling in schools, and detailed the steps the board has taken to ensure compliance. He also spoke about the accommodation review plan, which would usually be reviewed at this time, however, the process is under development and review by the Ministry and no direction has been provided at this time. Jennifer Johnston, District Principal of Learning responsible for Special Education shared information about Special Education Advisory Council (SEAC) and explained why an Individual Education Plan (IEP) survey was developed by the SEAC committee. The survey focused on communication, understanding, and participation by parents in an IEP process.
- Thursday, March 21, 2019: Director Hope shared what was known about the provincial government's intentions regarding secondary and elementary class size, the cell phone ban in classrooms, the Health and Physical Education Curriculum, the governments "back to basics" approach to mathematics, and the new elearning requirements.
- Thursday, May 9, 2019: Changes to the board's Adult and Alternate Education Centre locations were discussed and Director Hope provided clarification on the erroneous media reports that indicated that the AAECs were being closed down. The Ministry has not yet confirmed how school board's will be funded in regard to various budget items. Director Hope indicated that an overall change in how funding would be managed was to be expected. Presentation: "Understanding Unconscious Bias: Parents and Educators as Leaders of Social Change"
